<i>Area to Stitch</i>	<i>Thread & Number</i>	<i>Stitch</i>
Face	Skin: Soie D'Alger S2174 Mouth: Soie D'Alger 2645 Eyes: Soie D'Alger 3435 DMC floss 310, Blanc Eyebrows: Soie D'Alger 3435	Skin: Continental with one-ply Mouth: Oblong Cross with 2 plies Eyes and Eyebrows: Continental with 2 plies. Change the slant accordingly
Hair	Pure and Simple 19 Fyre Werks F9	Outline stitch Ruch the Fyre Werks and couch it in place
Veil	Londonderry Linen 1899 Black 18/3 The Collection Wonder Ribbon Silver (1)	Elongated Cashmere with the linen. Cut a length of the Wonder ribbon according to the design, stretch so that the mesh shows well, cut as needed according to the designs and then couch it in place on top of the area stitched with the elongated cashmere
Blue head thing	DMC #5 Pearl cotton 796 Ribbon Floss 042 Mill Hill Petite beads gold (40557) Memory Thread 6050 White, Kreinik Hot Wire 202HL	Pad the area with the Pearl Cotton and then Satin stitch with Ribbon Floss. String the beads and attach them following the design Twist 1 strand of Memory Thread and one strand of the Kreinik and couch it in place around the blue head thing
Dress	Necklace: S-J Designs 3 mm White Pearls, petite gold beads B button: (2) Gold necklace: Gold Millitary Met 2710 by Access Commodities, gold Blue area: Petite Very Velvet Kreinik V805, Kreinik #12 braid 051HL Trim on dress: Fyre Werks FT59, Swarovski 2 mm red crystals Memory Thread 6050 White, Kreinik Hot Wire 202HL	First attach the "B" letter in the allocated area. String the pearls and the beads and couch it in place Couch the trim Blue dress: Trim: Waffle stitch with Fyre Werks, stitch over the red points and when finish attach the red crystal in the middle Twist the 2 Memory Threads and couch it in place as was done in the head piece
Background	Soie Crystale 5123 Petite Silk Lame Braid SP58	

(1) If one doesn't want to use Wonder Ribbon one option is to do 4-way Continental with a #4 braid Kreinik in Silver. In this case no need to do the Londonderry linen, just stitch on top of the black
